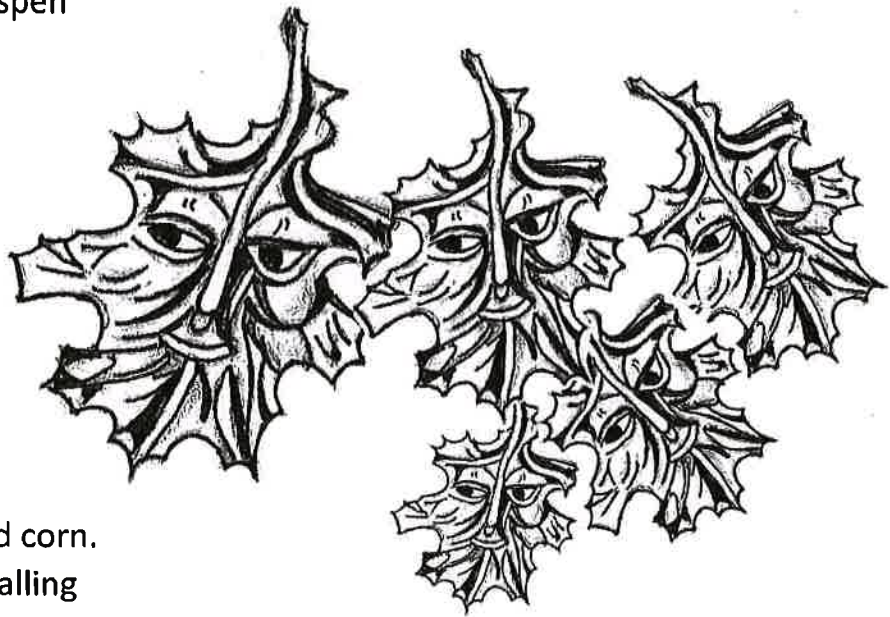


GOLDEN AUTUMN by Dee Shafer
