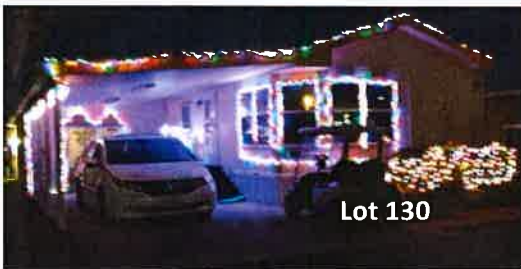


CHRISTMAS HOUSE DECORATING CONTEST
