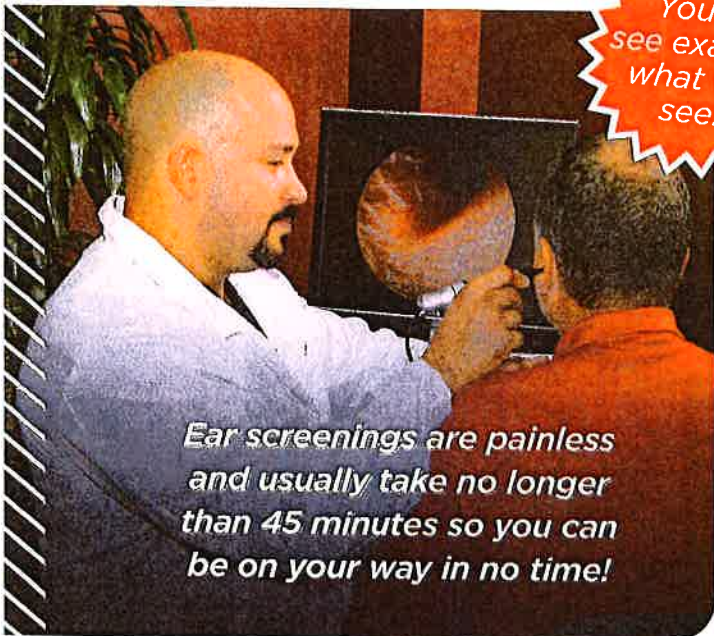

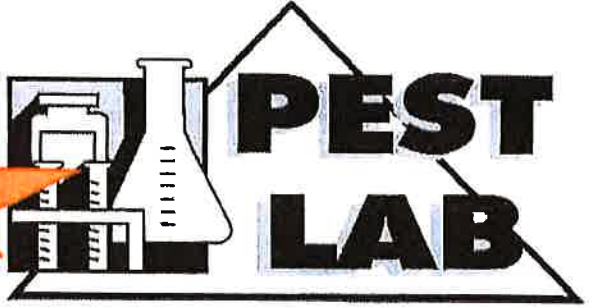

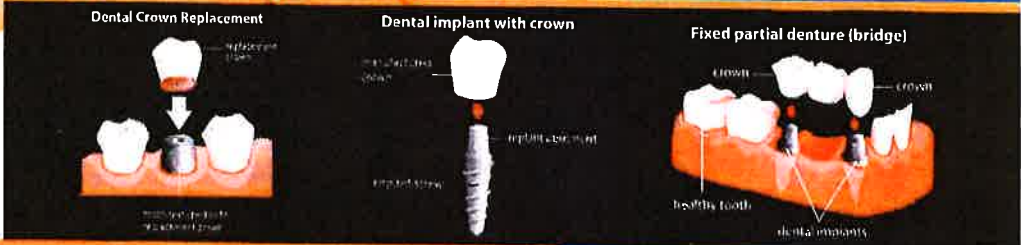

JANUARY 13, 2020

1. The pool, bar, and BBQ equipment may be reserved for a pool party based on availability by any resident.
2. The Activity Office will maintain a calendar/schedule and any use of the equipment must be scheduled through them (during the summer season, it will be scheduled through the business office).
3. When reserving this area, a request in writing indicating date, time, if any entertainment (which will be at the expense of the host/hostess unless previous arrangements have been made through the Activity Office), and number of expected attendee's breaking down number of residents and/or non-residents).
4. Once request is approved, the key for the BBQ may be obtained from the Activity Office.
5. There will be a \$50 deposit to be paid at the time of reserving the equipment/area which will be refunded in full once the equipment/area has been deemed "clean and useable" for the next person.
6. If an Activity is planned and scheduled for the pool area and non-residents are invited, there is a \$3 fee required for each attendee to be provided to the Business Office.
7. All existing pool usage rules must be adhered to and will be the responsibility of the "host/hostess" of any Pool Party to enforce those rules.
8. Once the activity has concluded, host/hostess must have either the Activity Department or Resort Managers accompany them to the area to insure it has been returned to it's usable state for refund of deposit.
9. Bar and bar stools are available for use at any time. **Please insure that they are recovered when no longer in use.**

SLOPPY JOES

I had many people ask me for the recipe for my sloppy joes after the Volunteer Appreciation Lunch. So I thought it would be easier to share with everyone in the Roundup. Actually I shared this recipe in my very first Roundup last year when I started the cooking with Kathy segment in November of 2018.

- 1 lb. lean ground beef (I use 90/10)
 - 1 Tbsp. oil (I omit this)
 - 1 c. chopped onions
 - 1 c. chopped green peppers (I omit this)
 - 1/2 Tbsp. sugar
 - 2 Tbsp. prepared mustard
 - 1 Tbsp. vinegar
 - 1 tsp. ground cloves
 - 1 c. catsup (if a little dry I add more to reach texture I want)
- Buns

In a frying pan cook beef in oil until brown. I break it up fine and add the onions and cook a little longer. Add remaining ingredients except buns. Cover, cook slowly for 30 minutes. Serves 6
